Authors are invited to submit a one-page abstract in English by September 2, 2026. The abstract should be submitted via the official online website (<http://intl.ksme.or.kr>). Registration is required before you submit an abstract. A participant can make one or two presentation(s); one registration can cover two presentations only.

Submission to JMST – Optional

If you are going to submit your paper to Journal of Mechanical Science and Technology (JMST, SCIE-indexed) to be considered for publication in a special section, a full paper prepared in the JMST template must be submitted by November 14, 2026.
